

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 01/02/2024

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Ivy Larrabee

Meeting called to order at 6:06pm by Joshua Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Per previous meeting minutes, Selectmen revisited the HRA amounts. The monthly price per employee will be \$1200.00 for the ICHRA.

Ivy spoke we had a call regarding the Kenney Road sign. The caller stated the road name was spelled wrong. Willie and Josh said they would drive to see if it was on the Knox side. Willie mentioned that he would check the hearse house for a Larrabee Road sign as well.

Josh spoke the Old County Rd Extension was repaired from the washout. There were ruts in this road as well that were repaired. The Weed Road had a load of gravel hauled to it to make plowing easier.

We received a request for a representative for a Hazard Mitigation Plan. Selectmen both spoke we would reach out to Steve Curry for this.

Contessa created a petty cash sheet. This will be used to keep track of money on hand, used for money orders. When we changed to The First National Bank, we were able to get in house check processing. Creating money orders will avoid having to pay anyone to go to the bank on a regular basis.

Selectmen spoke of inviting David Schofield to the next meeting to discuss the 911 officer details.

Josh spoke to Lance Oliver to review cemetery tree maintenance.

Ivy spoke of putting an article in the town meeting for foreclosure properties. We will put it out to a vote to required all three years back taxes to be paid to avoid foreclosure on properties that frequent the list.

The Selectmen both voted in favor of 5 days of vacation/ sick time to be rolled over into the new year. If the employee does not want to roll the time over into the new year, they are able to take this as payment instead. No more than 5 days left over each year will be rolled or paid out.

Josh spoke he has been in contact with Stewart Signs as something with the sign is not working correctly. The gentleman that was assisting in the installation spoke something appeared to have been broken in shipment.

Previous meeting minutes we spoke that the Saturday hours have been very slow. It does not seem to be beneficial to stay open as the business is less than the employee pay out. Josh spoke we would keep track of business for January, February, and March to review after.

Willie and Josh have been working to remove brush and trees from the side of the road from storm damage. They have also hired Jeff Henry to assist in this.

Ivy will be sending bids out for Assessing for the town, as well as curbside rubbish removal this week.

Josh spoke we needed to have a meeting with the Unity Selectmen to come up with a maintenance agreement for the Weed Road.
