Called to order at 6:12pm

Meeting Minutes from 01/06/2026

All warrants were signed

Expense and revenue reports were reviewed and accepted

Cathy Cross reviewed previous School Board meeting. There are school board member changes from Liberty and Troy. School Board will be starting a Facebook page once they figure out the technical side of it. RSU#3 is hosting Mount View Alumni to speak to public and students on various career paths and how they got there. Liberty now owns Walker Elementary building as the School Board offered it to the town when the school was closed. Morse Elementary still belongs to School Board Brooks is appraising the building to see about repurposing it. Waldo will be voting in the spring whether to leave the district. RSU 3 district enrollment has 948 students enrolled in public school with 251 students home schooled, going to the ecology school, etc. High school Wrestling Team is undefeated in their class. Budget as of December shows 53% expensed and 47% remaining, they may have not accounted for all revenue streams.

Mark and Vicky spoke about fine tuning the Solar ordinance with step-by-step procedures with the hopes of it being done by the March town meeting. The procedures will be used to verify inspection and approval of solar panel installation with multiple inspections throughout the installation process. They still need to determine how much it will cost for inspections on a per hour basis.

Road Plan for last year was \$33,658.69 over budget due to unforeseen expenses with the Oaks Road reclaim and road repairs due to wash outs in the spring.

Personal Property notice paperwork given to selectman to review from assessor. Selectman thought it looked good, but they want to know if there is anything not in BETE that is receiving or not receiving a value depreciation

Fire warden: Casey Palmer, Thorndike Fire Chief expressed interest in the position to Mackensie. Selectmen agreed that he can take on the position.

Mackensie's salary to increase to \$500 per week to be revisited in 3 months.


