

Selectman's Meeting 02/17/2026

Called to order at 6:02pm

Meeting Minutes from 02/03/2026 accepted as written

All warrants were signed

Expense and revenue reports were reviewed and accepted

Waldo County Mutual Aid Agreement signed just needs Fire Chiefs Signature

Shibles Road bridge email from Dirigo engineering showing entire cost we owe roughly \$1000 for engineering costs just waiting on the last bill. Josh has talked with Works's about options for installing the bridge since they would like to stop using Dirigo Engineering as they are taking too long to get back to us with quotes and other information. Josh has been looking into expanding the road to broaden from 28 feet at the top to 40 feet. They would like to add \$25,000 to the current budget to make sure the bridge does not go over budget.

The planned road budget for 2026 is \$150,000 with roughly \$90,000 of that budget being for paving the Oaks Road.

The last few adjustments for 2025 Warrant for Town Meeting were made. Those adjustments were for the Shibles Road and the general Road budget, the budget for clean-up day was increased to \$3800. Mackensie will make the adjustments on the document and have it printed for the Selectmen to come into the town office Wednesday to Sign the official warrant for posting.

The date for clean-up day was decided to be May 16th provided it works for bolsters. Josh mentioned talking to Joe West about helping like he has in previous years.

Josh got a call from a Company in Massachusetts about Digital mapping for the town property maps, they heard we were looking into it. Josh is going to wait until after town meeting to reach out to them about cost if the town approves the budget for digital mapping.

Mark discussed how he would like to get more people involved with the planning board and board of appeals he would also like to have at least 2 meetings with the selectboard every year but would prefer to meet quarterly with them. He also wanted to make sure he had the selectman's support on the radon detection project he has been working on.
