

## Selectman's Meeting 03/03/2026

Called to order at 6:03pm

Meeting Minutes from 02/17/2026 accepted as written

Expense and revenue reports were reviewed and accepted

Third Selectman Election ballots closed at 6:00pm with results of William Ingraham 21 votes. And Write-ins: David Schofield with 1 vote, Joseph Mark Chadwick with 1 vote, and Michael Wlodyka with 2 votes. This leaves a vacant seat on the selectboard until special election is complete. Election will probably be with the school budget election.

Clean up day will be May 16<sup>th</sup> as Bolsters are available that day, they will drop off the roll of dumpsters on the 15<sup>th</sup> and be available to do swap outs throughout the day on the 16<sup>th</sup>.

Animal Control officer, Peter Nerber, asked if the selectboard is ok with his Fiancé, Jessica Adams, being appointed as his deputy animal control officer for when he is not available, this will mostly come into effect during the summer when he is up north at the national parks. She is currently the animal control officer for Palermo and Montville. This will come at no additional cost for the town.

The planning board came to the meeting to discuss the solar ordinance and finalizing the ordinance for voting. There was a lot of discussion on who to contact for help in fixing the ordinance after having discussed the email from the town lawyer with his concerns on somethings being too vague. Mackensie will reach out to the town lawyer to see about adapting Freedoms solar ordinance as our own and if it is even possible, she will also contact MMA to see if it can be voted on during the vote for the school budget.
