

Selectmen's meeting minutes for 04/02/2024

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Jeffrey Stevens, Ivy Larrabee

Meeting called to order at 6:03pm by Joshua Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Expense Report and Revenue Report reviewed by all Selectmen.

Josh was sworn in, retitling his position as First Selectman, Road Commissioner, Assessor, and Overseer of the poor per Town Meeting approval.

We received an email from Dave Carlen regarding the culvert at the end of this driveway. He was requesting this to be reviewed as it seems to be collapsing. Josh said that this was our responsibility, and the Selectmen would review it.

Jacky Binette, our Assessors Agent, left notes for the Selectmen to review. Several accounts had miscellaneous corrections. This is in regard to personal property. This included one abatement request for Pat and Sandra Hayden. Selectmen voted in favor of approving this.

MRC has sent us a letter notifying us that they are still working to open the Hamden location, noted as the MWS Facility.

The Town sent out cemetery mowing bid requests. We received the following:
