Bills were sent to 2 residents for a title fee that got missed when registering their vehicles.

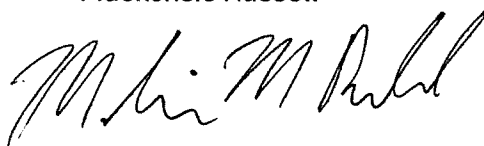
Clean up day was very successful with about 6 Rolloff dumpsters filled
