Called to order at 6:03pm

Meeting Minutes from 05/19/2026 and minutes from 05/26/2026 Public Hearing both approved

All warrants were signed: Warrant #45 - \$408,070.13

Expense and revenue reports were reviewed and accepted

The email that was received in May from FEMA has been taken care of by Mackensie and Contessa. It was some final paperwork that was missed a few years ago after repairing the Weed Road.

Excise Tax Agreement with Thorndike was signed

We received an email from a Water purification company about concerns of PFAS in wells, Selectboard members felt all needs and concerns were addressed by the State when the issue first presented itself.

Special Town Meeting Warrants were finalized and signed. 2 warrants were added from the original ones the select board had planned

Office received a complaint about the Bryant Lane being graded, complainant said the ditch was filled in.

Morse Road sign at the end of 137 is missing resident asked it to be replaced

The Oaks Road culvert was replaced as it was damaged when the road was graded. Paving should start within the next couple of weeks.

Josh said he hopefully will be ordering the bridge for the Shibbles Road within the next 2 weeks.

Contessa wants to get Mackensie's name on the Downeast Account. When she returns from vacation she will start the process.

There were many bags of bottles left on the side of the building on clean-up day, Poncho came and picked them up and was very happy to receive them and put the donation towards the flags.

MMA Legislative policy committee nominations are due June 4th, Josh doesn't know of anyone to nominate for the position.

Hans Schmidt brought a list of questions he would like to have the selectboard candidates answer so Residents can get to know who they are voting for. The selectboard thought the questions were good but there wasn't enough time to ask the questions and get answers out to residents before election day.

Final amount for school budget that was approved at the budget meeting is now available.

We received an email and phone call about someone interested in being Animal Control officer. The selectboard are not interested in the new person as they are happy with our Current Animal Control Officer.

The selectboard signed the Emergency Operations Plan for 2026.
