Special Town Meeting

To: Joseph M. Chadwick, A citizen of the Town of Knox, in the County of Waldo.

Greetings:

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Knox in said county of Waldo, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Knox Town Office in such Town on Saturday, June 13th, 2026 at 9:00am, then and there to act upon the following articles:

Art 1: To choose a moderator to preside over said town meeting.

Fifteen residents in attendance for the meeting. A motion was made for Rene Ouellet to be moderator. Motion was closed, moved to secret ballot. 3 votes in total, all for Rene Ouellet.

Art 2: To see if the town will vote in favor of adopting and accepting the Commercial Solar Ordinance from Freedom as discussed at the Public Hearing.

Art 3: To see if the town would vote in favor of raising and appropriating \$15,000 for Computer Repairs

Passed

Art 4: To see if the town would vote in favor of continuing to implement a tax club for residents currently in good standing with their taxes. Residents who choose to participate in the tax club, if approved, would avoid interest accrual and avoid the lien process.

Art 5: To see if the town would vote in favor of using \$60,000 from the Road Reserve Account to go towards the snowplow contract.

Passed

Art 6: To see if the town would vote in favor of using up to \$150,000 from Surplus to offset the tax commitment.

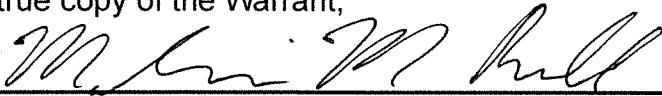
Josh Larrabee made a motion to lower the amount to \$100,000. Amendment of article passed.
