

Selectman's Meeting 06/16/2026

Called to order at 6:03pm

Expense and revenue reports were reviewed and accepted

Hans Schmidt spoke about the water that is coming into the sand shed and was wondering about the solution the selectboard had to prevent that this winter. He suggested that they pack clay around the cement blocks to seal them. Josh is going to work on the sand shed this summer. Hans also asked about the status on the Shibles road bridge, which the designs have been finalized and will be ordered soon it will cost roughly \$68,000. He also mentioned that the roads that have been graded don't have enough crown, especially Old County Road Extension, so the water is not running off the road.

The office received a letter asking for nominations for the Waldo County Commissioners budget committee, the selectboard has no one they can think of to nominate.

There was only one snowplow bid received. The selectman opened and read the bid from BoJames Spaulding stating \$250,000 for 29.6 miles of town roads and plowing town office parking lot for a five-contract starting in November 2026 ending in May 2031. The selectboard voted to accept the bid and will start finalizing the contract at the upcoming selectboard meetings.

Mackensie emailed three companies about repairing stones at cemeteries and received two replies. She will respond to those emails and set up a meeting with the company we had spoken to previously to start.

FC Works sent in the invoice for the grading and paving of Oaks Road for \$90,000.

The Historical Society sent an email to the Town Office asking if the town would like to purchase an ad for the calendar for the year 2027 and make it in memory of Willie. The selectboard said yes. They also asked to use the parking lot for a yard sale on a date yet to be determined.

Mackensie asked the selectboard which member would like to be the general assistant officer, Isaac volunteered. He will attend the class when it comes available.

Garrett Lower called Josh to see if we are interested in having him be our new Code Enforcement Officer. Josh is going to reach out to him after talking with David. He is going to have David attend the next Select Board meeting.

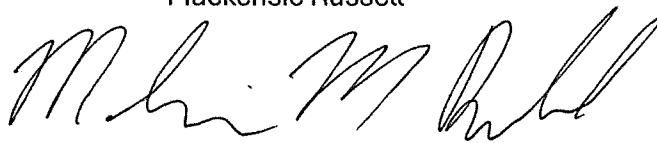
New Tax Maps have been returned and have been updated. This includes the new electronic maps
