

Selectmen and Board of Assessors meeting minutes for 06/17/2025

Meeting called to order at 6:14pm by Josh Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favor for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Ivy reviewed the tentative agenda for the special town meeting. Tentative date set for July 19th, 2025.

The Selectmen will wait until next meeting, July 1st, to vote on the proposed solar moratorium to allow sufficient time to read and review the document.

The Waldo County Commissioners' Office is requesting a nomination from the Town of Know for the Budget Committee. The Selectmen could not think of someone right in the moment but will review.

Josh has been in contact with Jennifer Work regarding dirt road grading. No time has been set yet for this to be completed.

We are still waiting for the variance signatures from the State Camp for our transfer station. They stated they need to come inspect it to approve the variance.

The required surveillance has been installed for the transfer station and is up and going.

Josh stated the Old County Road extension has washed out with the heavy rain. A resident on that road has contacted several times to review. Josh has already looked at it. It is washed but passable until they can get the equipment in to fix it.

Josh has reached out to a resident, Bill Littlefield, to complete our cold patching this year. Roads included are Abbott Road, Oaks Road, and the end of Patterson Ridge Road. Bill has agreed to do this for the Town.

Ivy told the Selectmen she had misplaced the invoice from Waldo County Lawn and Order for May, so they were not paid on time. Tim contacted the office, and May and June were paid in full.

Josh would like to have David come into the next Selectmen Meeting to review the new planning board arrangements.

The office received an invoice from Unity Flower Shop. Neither Contessa nor Ivy knew anything about it. Ivy called, Najean stated it was ordered by Marilyn and was told to charge the Town. Ivy asked Najean not to allow anyone to charge without prior Selectmen authorization.
