

Selectmen and Board of Assessors meeting minutes for 07/02/2024

In attendance: Willie Ingraham, Joshua Larrabee, Jeffrey Stevens, Ivy Larrabee, Hans Schmidt

Meeting called to order at 6:02pm by Willie Ingraham

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favored for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Expense and Revenue report was reviewed.

The Selectmen all signed Abatement for PP67 as resident has passed.

Ivy spoke that Richard Savage accepted the 50% excise reimbursement for his vehicle registration.

Poncho Bailey requested to put out a bottle donation bin at the office for flags. The Selectmen agreed to this. This will need to be kept clean and organized.

Brenda York came in and requested a "Speed Limit" sign and a "Slow, Children Playing" sign for the Morse Road. Jeff spoke he thought at one point there were both on the road. Willie made a motion to table this for the next meeting and he would review the road and that we have available in the hearse house.

Josh showed Willie and Jeff the current pricing list for the culverts, and they spoke of work that was to be started soon.

Ivy showed the Selectmen the RSU 3 referendum voting results.

Ivy also showed the Selectmen a thank you card for county tax payments, and the MMA Property and Casualty Pool coverage update.

We have a deadline for September for Dutton Pond road FEMA coverage. We have the work quoted and just waiting on contractors to start.

We have 4 BETE applications to be signed for personal property accounts and that will be completed for the 2024 tax commitment.

Ivy reminded Willie of the General Assistance meeting he has July 9<sup>th</sup> for our yearly review.

Hans attended the meeting to review his personal property account again. He has pulled bills from 2011 to review with the Selectmen the value changes. They reminded Hans these changes were made by people that are no longer in office and they cannot speak to what decisions were made then. Hans signed a payment plan with the town for his 2023 personal property bill to exclude interest. He feels this is no longer valid. The Selectmen and Hans could not come to an agreement as Hans feels he is over valued, but does not want to be reassessed. Josh spoke that because he signed a payment agreement and has never paid his personal property bills he's speaking of, the bill still stands as billed in 2023.

Hans then spoke of the sand shed having standing water in it. He has reviewed it and said there are 8 holes where water is coming in. Willie and Jeff reviewed this and stated it was due to the heavy rain we have had in the last week and there was no water in the sand shed at the time.

Hans then spoke of the potholes. Jeff stated we have purchased cold patch for repairs and will be starting soon.
