Expense and revenue reports were reviewed and accepted

Jeff asked on the status of Sand pile bids, Mackensie sent bid letters to 4 businesses and posted it on the website. The office has not received any official bids

MWC and Bolster's sent an email to the office to let residents know that trash will now be going to Hampden, the waste bypass sending all roadside pick up to Norridgewock has been lifted.

MRC/MWC is looking for a nominee for the board of directors, nomination paperwork is due October 19th.

Auditors sent the draft 2025 audit to the office. The selectmen reviewed and signed the audit.

David brought in concerns about campers being parked in town for extended periods of time. His biggest concern is how these people are disposing of their solid waste. He feels there needs to be an ordinance for campers and that if people are to be living in a camper for an extended period of time there should be some type of permit system in place to help to make sure people are complying with state laws. He is going to work with the planning board to make an ordinance.

Mark brought up the building ordinance and the process of issuing permits. There is a lot of confusion about how the ordinance is written. David and the selectboard feel the ordinance needs to be updated including the payment schedule. Mark would like residents to pay for their permit before it is reviewed and approved. Mark and David will discuss the best way to go about permit application reviews and approvals in the meantime.
