

Selectmen and Board of Assessors meeting minutes for 10/15/2024

Meeting called to order at 5:57pm by Josh Larrabee

Previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Voted all in favor for approval.

The warrants were reviewed and signed.

Expense and Revenue reports were reviewed.

The plaque for the oldest person in Knox was ordered and delivered. Willie will reach out to Loretta's sons to set up a time.

Ivy spoke to Bill Kelly regarding the personal property accounts that are unpaid from 2023. The Selectmen all agreed to move forward with the accounts over \$100, four in total. Ivy has forwarded the information to Bill and will be waiting for the next steps.

Bruce Cook has reached out to the town regarding the Unity Ambulance committee. As of right now we have not found anyone interested in being apart of this. We will be reaching out to a few people to see if we can find anyone.

We ordered one more load of salt from Eastern Salt Company, set to be delivered 10/16/2024.

We received a contact request from MDOT for capital paving project on 137. Josh was set as the point of contact for this.

The linseed oil has been applied to the blocks in the sand shed.

John Cranouski has started putting up sand pile.

Contessa has sent out impending foreclosure notifications to 12 accounts.

FC Works has been in contact with Josh for the Larrabee Road. They gave him a few options for repairing the road. The Selectmen discussed the differences between the options and what would hold best, they all voted in favor of moving forward with re shouldering the road, grinding it, and a 3" Binder, with 2". Jennifer gave us a rough figure of \$48,500. This is within the presented 2024 road budget.
