

Selectman's Meeting 11/18/2025

Called to order at 6:05pm

Meeting Minutes from 11/04/2025 approved

All warrants were signed

Expense and revenue reports were reviewed

Mark and Vicky spoke about radon gas and the proposed project to start getting the town tested and what they would need for that. The selectman agreed it was a good idea but need to make sure of town interest before committing fund to the project.

Properties foreclosed on the Bailey Road sale has been closed on 11/14/2025. Josh brought in Closing paperwork and a check. The Shibles Road property still does not have a closing date

Cindy Larrabee dropped off paper for Grant for Snowmobile Club that was signed by Jeff Stevens

Whitcomb Contracting sent a bid for Shibles Road bridge installation at \$189,900. Waiting for another bid from F.C. Works. Also, the selectmen are still waiting on the final cost of the bridge estimated \$80,000 to \$90,000

Waste Hub sent a ballot for Board of Directors to be voted on All Selectman agreed to vote for Tony Smith out of the three options provided.

Discussed the town Bank Account and who should be on the account all Selectman agreed that All three Selectman, Contessa, and Mackensie should be on the account

Last Saturday of the Month office hours will close for November and December. Will look at audit reports for previous months this year at a later date to determine if the Office should be open on the last Saturday starting again in January.

The idea of a locked drop box in or at the office for people to drop stuff off when the office is closed was mentioned. All selectmen liked the idea but need to determine the best location and cost.

Town resident informed the office of missing road signs, the four-way Morse Road and Belfast Road, also Kenney Road sign on the Belfast Road end are missing. Will have to check Hearse House to see if they are in there and have them put up or ordered.

Josh is trying to find someone to work on the cemeteries and will call Bill


American Flag by Veterans memorial is leaning on flagpole Willie will look at it and see if he can fix it.
